

TRIANGULAIRE 2026

France – Belgique – Luxembourg

RULES

Competition limited to 40 participants per country.

Maximum handicap 24.4 (Handicap to be submitted by countries by the registration deadline of April 15, 2026).

Note: Golf Cart are prohibited (except for those over 70 years of age or with a medical certificate).

Format

Day 1:

Stableford 4 BBB (net) - Red tees.

One division.

The lowest scores from each country are removed: the number of cards removed is equal to the total number of cards divided by 8 (number rounded down to the nearest whole number).

Example: for 20 teams per country, 2 cards are removed ($20/8 = 2.5$)

for 15 teams per country, 1 card is removed ($15/8 = 1.8$)

The score for each country is equal to the total of the scores of the cards considered divided by the number of these cards.

Day 2 :

Stableford single (brut & net) - Red tees.

One division.

Same as for the 4BBB

Ex: for 40 players per country, we remove the last 5 scores ($40/8 = 5$).

For 30 players per country, we remove the last 3 scores ($30/8=3.75$).

The score of each country is equal to the total of the considered cards' scores divided by the number of these cards.

Prize-giving (each country is free to choose its prizes)

4 net prizes for doubles

1 brut prize + 4 net prizes for simples

Triangular Tournament Ranking

Is done by adding the two net results: 4 BBB and singles for the 3 countries.

In case of a tie, the tie-break will be determined by the first discarded singles card, then the second...

The winning country takes the Challenge.
